 - 1. How do you enforce this agreement?
 - A. Has to be filed annually with either the postdoc office or HR
 - 2. Can be tied together with the mentor agreement
 - 3. Link with the Research Deans to help get this info out
 - B. Keynote speaker
 - a. Economic crisis with postdocs
 - 1. In order to improve the postdoc situation, we should decrease the number of postdocs by creating more permanent research positions, then the remaining postdocs could be paid more
- 11. Advising officer for international postdocs
 - A. Should this position remain / what would the responsibilities be?
 - a. Arguments for this position (Hadi)
 - 1. Over half of the postdocs are international
 - A. They have specific issues (i.e. visas)
 - 2. Someone needs to coordinate with the International Office
 - 3. Orientation for international postdocs, redirecting people to the appropriate resources
 - b. Here's the plan, we can vote on the bylaws today, Hadi will come back to us by the next meeting with a list of proposed responsibilities for this position. Then we can vote on whether to include this position in the bylaws as an amendment at the next meeting
